

## Handwashing blessing (recited by Lippman students)

It is a Jewish tradition to wash your hands and recite a blessing right before saying the *Motzi*, blessing over bread.

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה ה', אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, אֲשֶׁר קִדְּשָׁנוּ בְּמִצְוֹתָיו, וְצִוָּנוּ עַל  
נְטִילַת יָדַיִם.

*Barukh Ah-ta A-donai E-lo-hai-nu Meh-lekh Ha-olam, A-shair Kid-  
shanu B'Meetz-vo-tav V'tzee-va-nu ahl n'tee-lot ya'da'yeem.*

Praised be You, Lord Our God, who has made us holy His commandments  
and has commanded us to wash or hands.
